- International Coquitlam Scout Badge of Honour

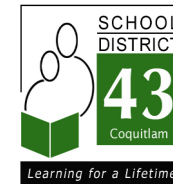


Each student enrolled in a program of 3 weeks or more will participate in an overnight camp and will receive basic school supplies and a quality sleeping bag and back pack to keep.
