FULL REFUND LESS APPLICATION FEE will be given if Canadian Immigration does not approve a student study permit.

1/2 REFUND will be given if the student withdraws prior to commencement of the program. All requests for refunds must be made in writing.

NO REFUND will be granted to a student after commencement of the program. This includes students who are dismissed from the program due to a breach of the law, policy or regulation as determined by the Government of Canada, the police. School District No. 43 (Coquitlam) and/or the International Education Program.
